

Faculty Constitution Approval Schedule

1. Constitution distributed to University Faculty (10 working days prior to University Faculty Meeting)
2. University Faculty Meeting (20 working days prior to vote)
3. Website Update (10 working days prior to vote)
4. Voting Period (3 consecutive working days)

If the Constitution is given final Senate approval on October 9, 2017:

- Tuesday, October 10 – Copies distributed
- 2:30pm, Wednesday, October 25 - University Faculty meeting (location TBD)
- Monday, November 27– First day of voting (runs for 3 days)

The University Faculty will be given the opportunity to meet and discuss an amendment at least 20 working days prior to a faculty vote thereon. Copies of the proposed amendment shall be distributed to all members of the University Faculty at least ten (10) working days in advance of the meeting. Modifications to the wording of an amendment can be made by majority vote of the University Faculty present at the meeting.

At least ten (10) working days prior to a faculty vote on any amendment, all members of the University Faculty will have access to a web page that posts the proposed amendment and summarizes the discussion of the University Faculty meeting. No changes in the wording of any amendment can occur after it is posted.

Voting on any amendment will occur over a time period of three (3) consecutive working days.
