Roughly \$2M in receivables are collected by the AG annually. The AG assesses a collection fee to each account that varies between 23% to 28%. This PO enables the University to remit the collection fees to the AG for delinquent payments made directly to the University.</p>

It is estimated that the University saves \$6,000 annually by electing this payment method.</p>

<b>Vendor:</b>	<b>RoundTower Technologies</b>	The Isilon storage systems which support faculty, staff, and students across all of Wright State's campuses and its disaster recovery site contain many components which are approaching end-of-life. This upgrade directly enhances the system installed at the Dayton Campus; it also allows upgrade of the disaster recovery site through redeployment of components, which have not reached end-of-life. Benefits offered by this upgrade include: increased storage capacity, increased performance, and decreased yearly maintenance expenditures.
