COVID Legislative Update

- **H.B. 218: COVID-19**

- A university shall not require a student or employee to receive a vaccine, drug, biological product, or genetic immunotherapy that utilizes mRNA, DNA, or any other genetic vaccine technology that has not been granted a biologics license from the FDA.
- If a university requires an employee to receive a vaccine, drug, biological product, or genetic immunotherapy that utilizes mRNA, DNA, or any other genetic vaccine technology that has received full FDA approval, the employee can satisfy the requirement by:
 - Taking the vaccine, drug, biological product, or genetic immunotherapy that utilizes mRNA, DNA, or any other genetic vaccine technology;
 - Taking the vaccine, drug, biological product, or genetic immunotherapy that utilizes mRNA, DNA, or any other genetic vaccine technology that is available under Emergency Use Authorization;
 - Filing an exemption with the university, which include:
 - Medical contraindications (Employee provides a doctor's note that is signed by the physician),
 - Natural immunity (Employee provides results of antibody testing that shows the presence of antibodies equal or in excess to what a vaccine provides)(ODH will set policy on frequency of antibody testing),
 - Reasons of personal conscience (Student just has to provide written statement which must be honored),
 - Religious convictions (Employee just has to provide written statement which must be honored)
- This Bill replaces **HB 477, HB435, HB248**
- **SB 209**
 - This would prohibit a campus-wide mask mandate for classes or activities (including activities at the Nutter Center) unless it is in a medical setting

COVID Update – Court Injunctions

- Federal Requirement for Vaccination for Employers with federal contracts
 - Federal Court Injunction Nov 30
 - 3 states only KY, OH, TN
- OSHA Mandate
 - Employers over 100 employees
 - Ohio is one of the 26 states not governed by OSHA
 - Ruling on November 16, consolidating all challenges (34 petitions) to the Sixth Circuit in Ohio
